

1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

The four gospels and the four living ones are the manifestation of Christ in wisdom (Lion King in Matthew), righteousness (Servant in Mark), sanctification (Set apart to God in Luke), and redemption (the Soaring Eagle made free in John). We lack nothing in Jesus.

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

Be full and overflowing with peace, rest and satisfaction. Fully able and prepared not just to get by, but to super abound unto Him to every good work. Redemption is beyond. It not only means to rescue from captivity and bondage, but to completely satisfy every obligation and liability.

Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

Not only did Jesus free us and pay it, but He became the curse – so that we can be highly favored – grace – He will grow us up into all things.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

We were made free, not set free. If we were just set free we could be captive again. When made free you can't be anything but free!

Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Get satisfied and settled that the debt is paid and the ransom is fully met, and grow in grace. Redeemed by the blood is permanent. “You is what you is in Christ and it's not going to change.” In that faith we live another part of the redemption plan. God wants His children to grow up. The same blood does the growing up. The cherubim look on the mercy seat (the blood). You don't start one way and grow in another way. The all inclusive redemption plan can grow up a son that walks in the spirit and not the flesh. It transforms me to be the man I could never be. The spirit wins every time – the power of the I AM's might can break down every strong hold. The chains the enemy is telling you that you have are made make-believe by faith. You've been made free!

Romans 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

This bold cry of Abba, Father brings us to the final thought. We are waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body! He bought me and I am His!

Ephesians 1:13-14 . . . after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, ¹⁴Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

Romans 8:23 And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit*, the redemption of our body.

He says, “Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away.” (SOS 2:10)

He lead captivity captive, and there is a company that's captive today that He is getting ready to free. It's a company groaning to see His lovely face; and it's not just a company it's a body. Jesus is coming soon!
