

John 2:9-10 When the ruler of the (*wedding*) feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, ¹⁰And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: *but thou hast kept the good wine until now.*

Revelation 21:11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

Revelation 21:23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

Thank Him for the trials, for despairing of your own life. He is teaching you to come out from yourself and be the man of God He has called you to be. You must believe. Let Him speak to you. Christ in you desires this high calling for you. He will perfect and finish that masterpiece in you. Christ in me, the hope of glory.
