

**Hebrews 2:9-10** But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. <sup>10</sup>For it became him, for whom *are* all things, and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

Jesus is perfect but this perfect is something different, He could not fail, yet the perfection only comes from sufferings. The enemy would try to get us to think we can never be perfect, but Jesus says by my spirit you can. When we face everything by faith we are more than conquerors. Faith never fails – it's impossible. Faith is the word of God.

**Romans 10:17** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

We are on the same course - perfected through sufferings. But unlike Jesus who could not fail or deny even one suffering – we can. Jesus could not be anything but obedient to the Father, but you and me, we can, we were born in sin and shapen in iniquity. So something greater has to be done to overcome this nature. The greater thing we can do is not draw back in unbelief, or if we do falter, we arise and by grace we prevail.

**John 14:12** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Jesus was encouraging us – He said don't worry or fret, I'm sending a Comforter. He will lead you into all truth and you will be able to live by the power of my might.

**John 14:16-17, 26** And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; <sup>17</sup>Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. <sup>26</sup>But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

**Acts 1:8** But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you:

Do you see who we are in Christ? We are of the same spirit, we are born of God, Christ lives in us. When we stand before the Father we stand in the exact same favor as Jesus Christ.

**1 John 3:9** Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

If you are a child of God you cannot sin. This is the life of Christ.

**Galatians 2:20** I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

That's the power of God unto salvation. That's the life He has given you, the very best. This is why He said you will do greater works, because you will be filled with the Holy Ghost. You are going to live by the power of His might. You will be able to stand and withstand. He will make you the man you could never be because Christ lives in you. In that you have power. Satan is defeated. How precious that when we fail, we can be restored by grace. There is nothing more precious to God than a broken heart and contrite spirit. I need His grace! He's glorying in you in the work of faith by grace. He's glorying in His workmanship in you. You have to get the vision of how He loves you. Through sufferings we too are being made perfect. Ready to be sitting in the midst of the throne. He made the way, because He is the Captain of my salvation!
