How do I combat the sin that comes up against me in this life?

1. Well first of all let's go over to **Gal. 2:20**: "**I** am crucified with Christ: **nevertheless I live**; yet not **I**, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which **I** now **live** in the flesh **I live** by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." We are a new creation in Christ.

**Eph 4:24**: "And that ye put on the new man, which after God is **created** in **righteousness** and true **holiness**." We are as holy and as righteous as we will ever be at the very moment we are born again, and now it is time to grow up in it. Become perfect the Bible tells us, and that perfect means to mature, to become mature Sons of God, and to be no more like children.

2. Remember that: "...whatsoever is not of faith is sin." **Rom. 14:23**.
3. **Rom. 7:18-19**: "For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but [how] to perform that which is good I find not. For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do." We see here that we need power from up on high to defeat this, and that's just what we have.

**I John 4:4**: "Greater is He that is in me than He that is in the world." Christ Jesus' very own life is in you.

**Phil 4:13**: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." God's love toward us gave us all the divine Grace needed to overcome the wickedness in this world, that we should no longer be the servant of sin, but the temple of God, magnifying His faithfulness as a full over-comer in Christ.
