Why is Salvation (the way we get to heaven) only in the name of Jesus?

1. **Heb 11:6** says, "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

God set it up this way because He is God. God sets the rules, and clearly told us that His ways are not our ways, nor His thoughts our thoughts.

**Is. 55:8-9:** "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts."

**Rom 3:23:** "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

**Rom 3:10:** "There is none righteous, no, not one."

**Ps. 51:5:** "Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me." We were born in sin.

**John 3:7:** "Ye must be born again." (saved)

2. The world falsely teaches that there are many ways, but the Bible clearly tells us there is but one way.

**John 14:6:** "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

**I Tim. 2:5:** "For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus."

**I Tim. 2:4:** "Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth." Christ wants all to be saved & come to a full knowledge of the Truth.

**Rom. 10:9:** "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."
