Lesson 9
The challenge of Godly living

1. The Holy Spirit through Paul tells it like it is.
Romans 7: 18 & 19 "For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not. For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do." In ourselves, our self works and efforts, we will never find the way to Godly living.
Matthew 26: 41 "The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." It must be the Spirit, the new man, the new creation, the very life of God that He gives His children.
