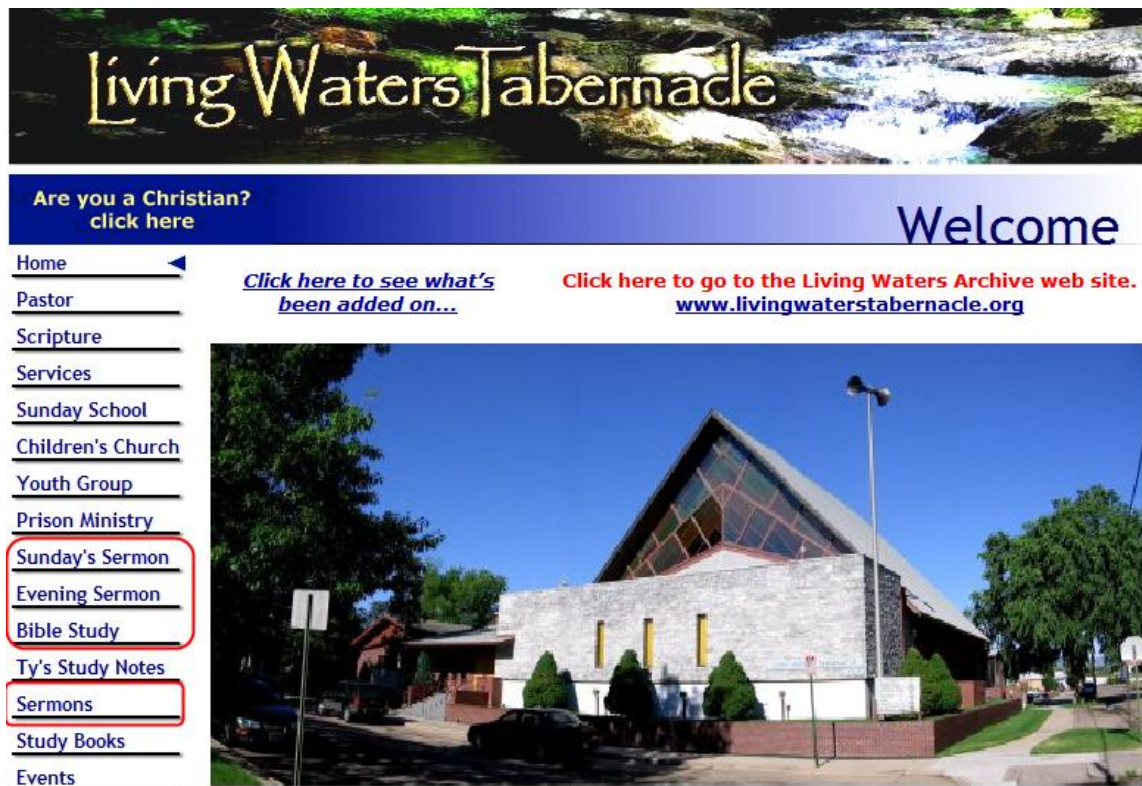


Accessing MP3 (audio sermons), WMA (music) files, and WMV (video sermons)

1. Go to Livingwatersternacle.com and select the desired section on the left such as Sunday's Sermon or Bible Study.

Notes: The options for downloads on the main website are:

- Sunday Sermons (6 past weeks)
- Evening Sermons (6 past weeks)
- Bible Studies (currently the 17 past weeks)
- Sermons – Special sermons
- LWT Music – Specials (.wma files and .mp3 files)
- Click on the www.livingwatersternacle.org option to access older sermons and studies.
 - Search for these sermons by Title or Book
 - Select Bible Studies to access older Bible studies
 - LWT Music – music specials



2. You will be taken to a new screen displaying the recent sermons. Right click on the sermon or music and select Save Target As...

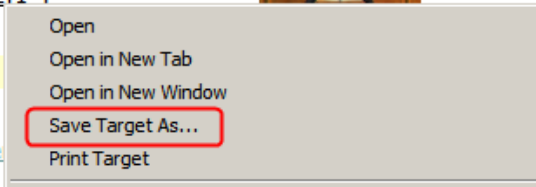

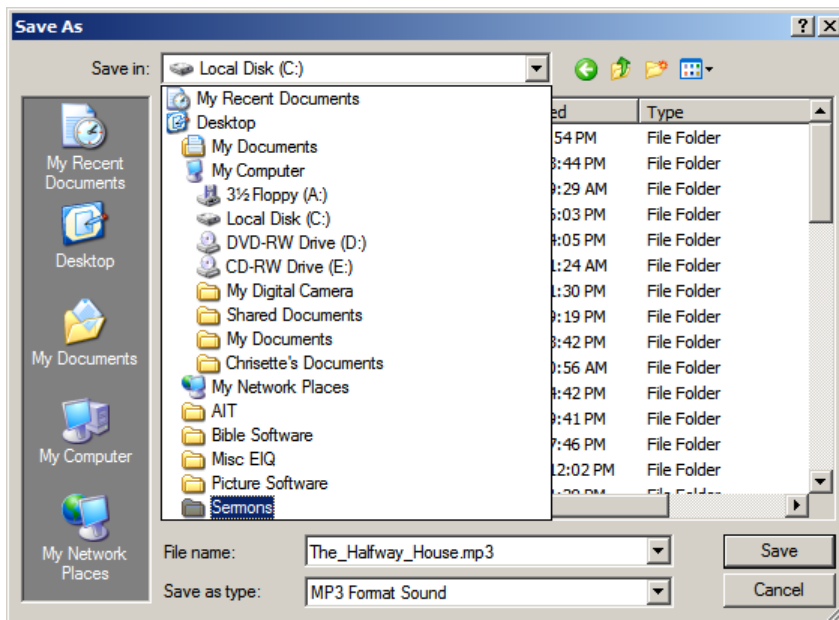

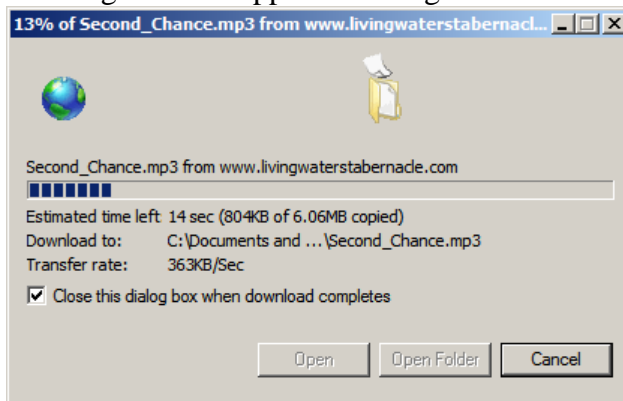

3. Select the location on your computer to put the file. You can create a new folder for all of the sermons. The file name will fill in for you automatically.

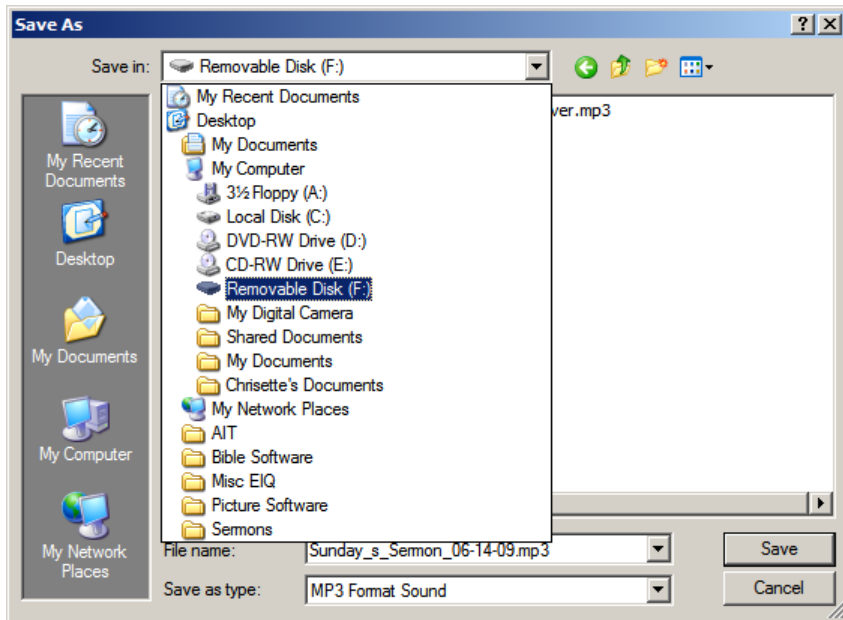


A dialog box will appear showing the status of the download.

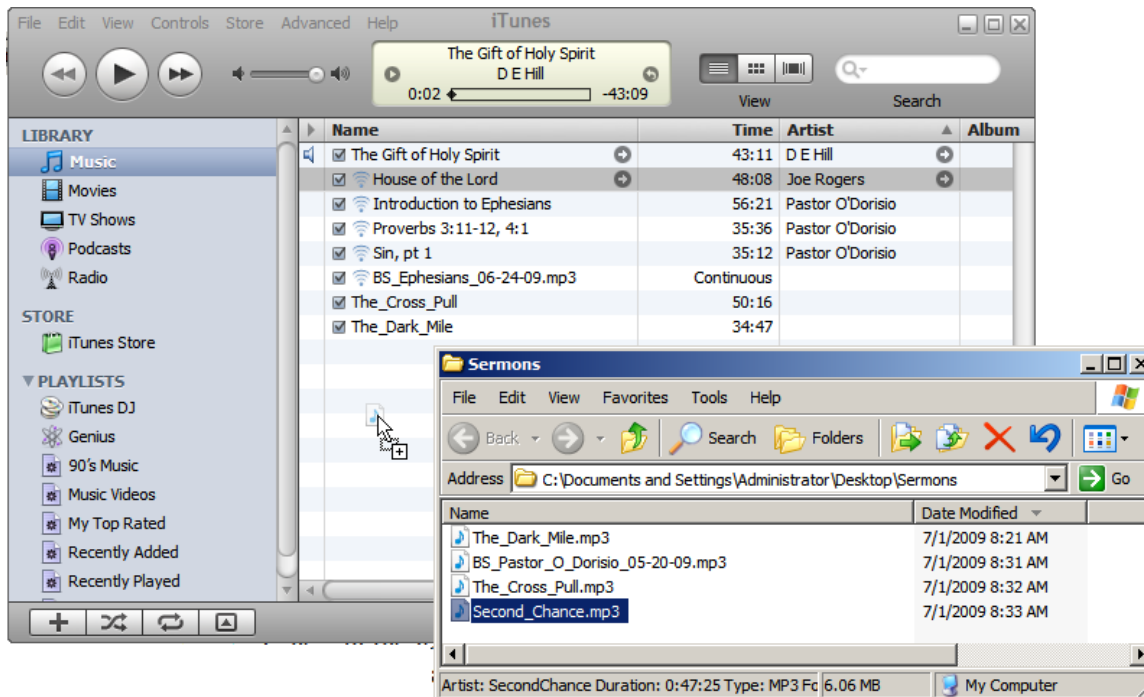


Once it is complete the file is now on your computer in the selected location. You can now transfer the file to your MP3 player as you would any music. The instructions for this depends on your MP3 player. (See below for iTunes information).

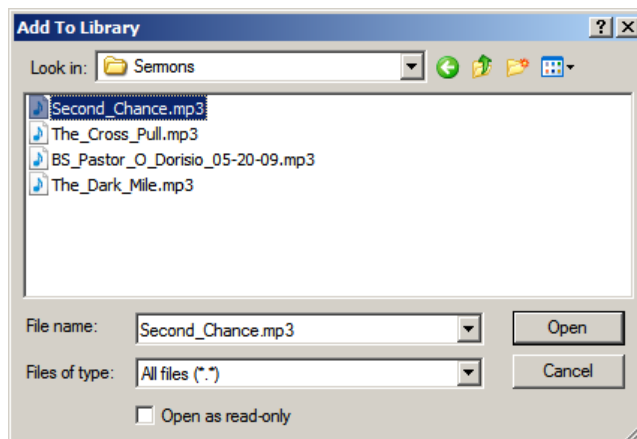
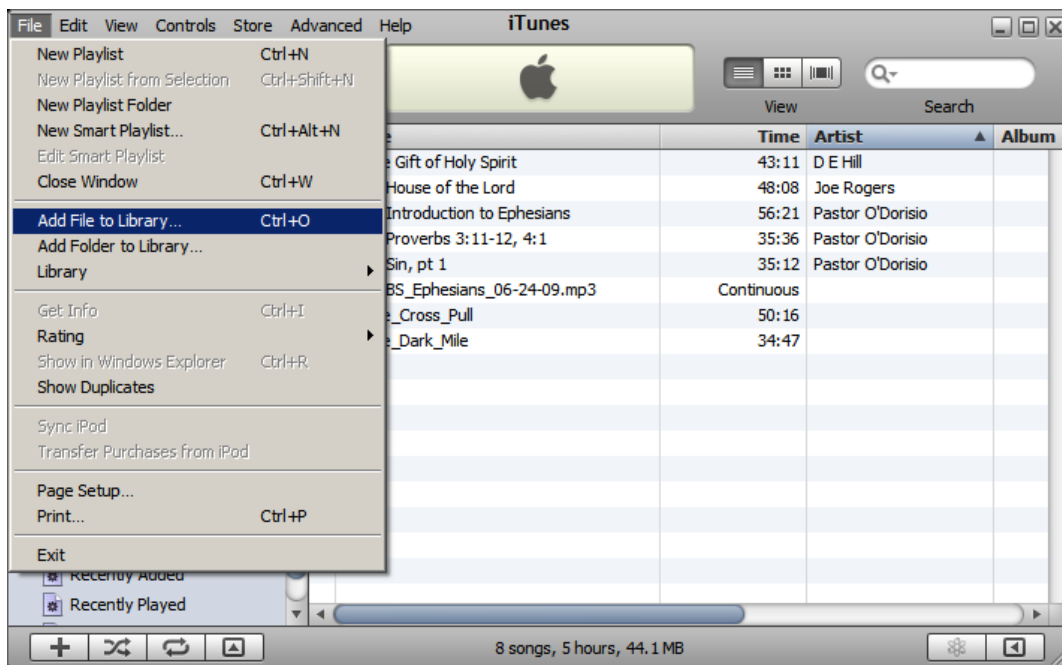
4. As an alternative, if your MP3 player is plugged into your computer it will be listed as a drive and you can put the file directly there.



5. If you use iTunes you can drag and drop the file from the location that it was downloaded to into a library in iTunes. (Drag and drop is done by holding down the left mouse button).



Or, from iTunes click on the File menu. Select "Add File to Library". In the window that opens find the location of the file you downloaded the Sermon/Music file to. Double click on the file or highlight it and select Open. This will load the selection into iTunes.



From iTunes, in the left hand column, click on "Recently Added". This opens the Library location where you placed your Sermon/Music file. Find the file you want and left click on it and drag it to the left column under "Devices", (your iPod should be listed there). At the top, center of the page you see the sync process begin. It will tell you when it is complete.
